Must be able to follow key instructions, read maps, be highly organised and able to always conduct themselves in a courteous and professional manner, as they will be a part of the OMEX team. The area of coverage will predominantly be South Lincolnshire, however you may be required to work in other surrounding counties.

Main Duties

- Liaise closely with our commercial team, including our District Sales Managers and the Lead Soil Sampler
- Process sample requests received via email or by hand
- Prepare soil bags and relevant documentation in readiness for collecting soil samples
- 25 to 30 points to be sampled from each field.
- Delivery of samples to our Kings Lynn laboratory
- Responsible for the upkeep of the soil sampling vehicle
- Be competent in soil sampling procedures – training will be given
- Be able to map read to a high level of accuracy
